

OFDNA General Meeting Minutes
September 28, 2006

Bruce Ronning gave presentation about parks. He informed the crowd that the parks and Rec department is looking at Southeast Bend for a larger area park. The Parks Dept. has talked with Jan Ward but doesn't have the land yet. Bruce also talked about the current system of SDC fees in contrast with the system they used to have to raise park money which was an 8% dedication of land or an equal value in cash. He feels that the system we have currently works better.

Three people volunteered for the OFDNA board and were elected by unanimous decision. Our new board members are: Jill Grow, Mike Betsch, and Adam Apalatequi. Nan Loveland and Shirley Walkey volunteered to remain on the board for another year so there would be a quorum.

Daryl Loveland led a discussion and vote on where the audience felt were OFDNA's traffic hot spots. The three locations that got the most votes were 1. 15th and Ferguson (straightening the corner), 2. American Lane and Reed Market Road (make no left turns onto Reed Mkt.) and 3. general excessive speed problems on 15th Street. Other hot spots that were brought up were 1. 15th and Wilson, 2. Foxfire and Brosterhous (Foxfire being blocked off), 3. Brosterhous at the two right angle turns, and 4. Murphy Crossing at the railroad tracks. There was one objection to double roundabouts and one other comment that the roundabouts were too small to function well.
