

Southeast Bend Neighborhood Association
Minutes
November 19, 2008

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 p.m. The meeting was held at the South Bend Fire Station. The members attending the meeting were John Snippen, Dick Selby, Harold Anderson, Maureen Schlerf, Ron Garland, John Alkire, Ellen, Glasgow, Kristi Erickson and guest Kathy Leming.

Kristi read the minutes from September's monthly meeting and October's general meeting. The minutes were read and approved by all.

Harold presented a draft of compliance reporting needs that will go into effect January 1, 2009. One of the compliance issues is having meeting minutes posted to the website in a timely manner.

General Neighborhood Issues

John Snippen regrettably resigned his position with SEBNA due to the recent sale of his house in this neighborhood association. Because he does not own land in our area, he can no longer sit on the board.

Harold reviewed the ballots for the re-election of our board. The entire board was re-elected unanimously.

Helen reported that there is a meeting being held at Hollinshead Barn November 20, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. covering what is new at the Bend Parks and Recreation department. There is a dog park slated to happen January 1, 2009 in our area.

The board discussed the desired positions for the future of the board. One of the issues raised was time commitment for each person and change of some positions. Ron is still interested in dealing with the land use issues. Maureen will take the treasurer's position for at least one more year. Dick is going to be the co-chairman with Harold Anderson. John Alkire has committed to attending the monthly transportation meetings and has committed for two years on the board. Kristi has committed to one more year and the secretary position.

Harold attended a meeting and testified about the signage problem at the Murphy Road and Highway 97 intersection. The signs that hang from the stoplights are not hanging on the correct side. ODOT is supposed to do something about it.

The city has proposed to have a city booth at functions that everyone can use for things such as membership drives instead of the neighborhood associations having to have their own table.

Service Master is doing a citywide drive for necessary survival items. On December 13th from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. they will have trucks going around to sites to pickup items.

Kathy Leming was elected unanimously to the board.

Land Use

Ron reported that there is no activity in our area at this time. Harold did have information about a project that may affect us because of the sewer that is involved. The actual project is not in our area, but the future sewer system is.

Budget Report

Ellen reported that we have \$748.81 in the budget at this time which has to last until June 30th.
